Financial UPDATE

In the past three years, we have charted significant growth. We've increased our camps to nine from four and grown campus groups to 83. We minister to 15,000 youth. We couldn't have done this without the support of thousands of ministry partners.

To manage growth, we increased support services and set growth-oriented revenue targets. However, this year was challenging and we did not meet donation and camper fee targets. As a result, we faced an operational deficit at year-end.

Moving forward, we are working hard to increase donations and camper fees while projecting more conservative revenues and decreased expenses in our 2013-14 budget.

In the midst of challenge, we are grateful for God's provision through the generosity of his people.

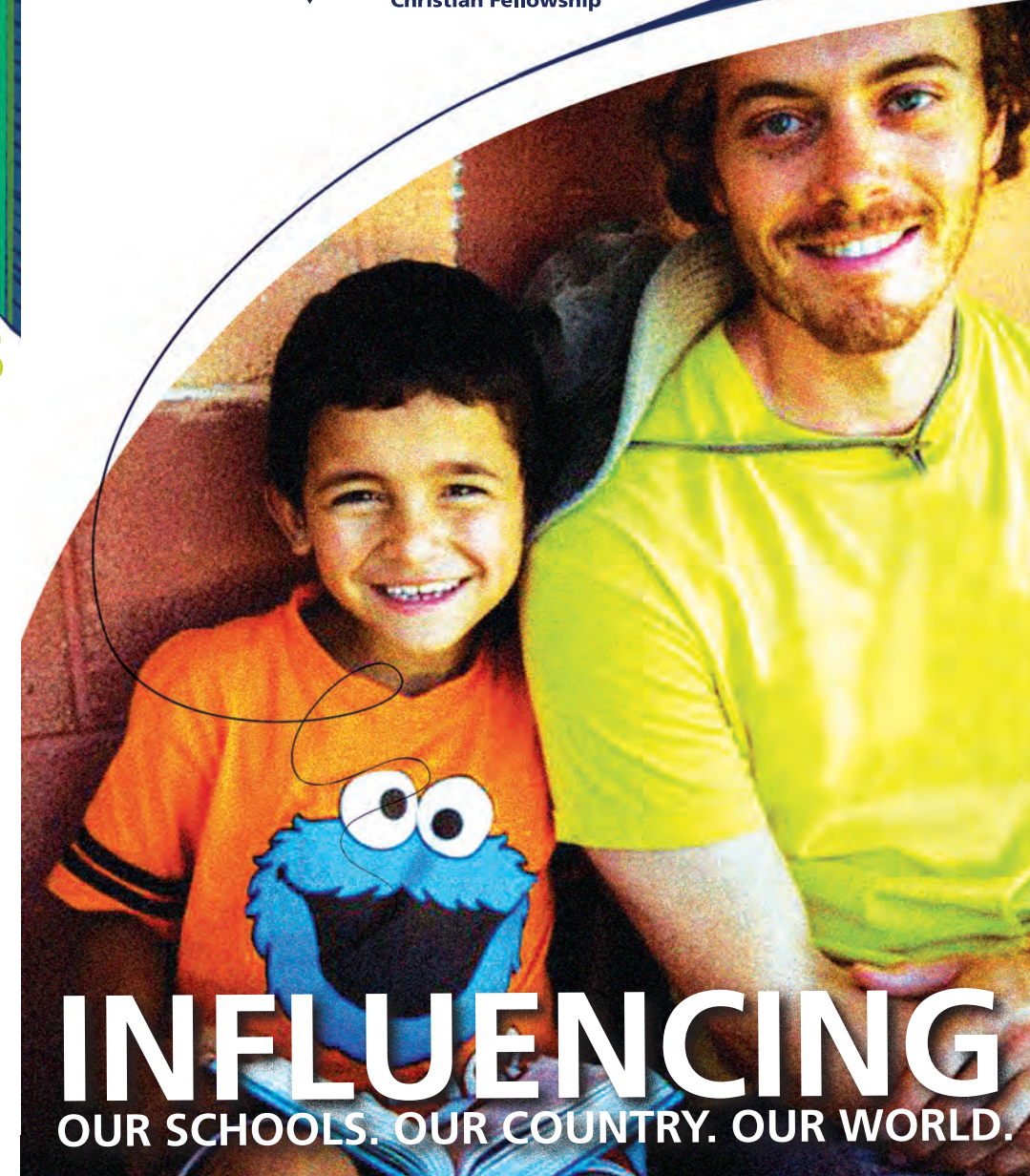
