The Annual General Meeting of Inter-Varsity Christian Fellowship's Board and Corporation will be held on February 5, 2015. At that time, the Financial Statements for the Fiscal Year 2013-14 will be approved and made available publicly. Previously, the Financial Statements were approved in November, coinciding with the publication of our Annual Ministry Report. With the change in the Annual Meeting date, we have chosen to issue two reports, an Annual Ministry Report now, and an online Annual Financial Report in February.
