- Set up and oversee buffets

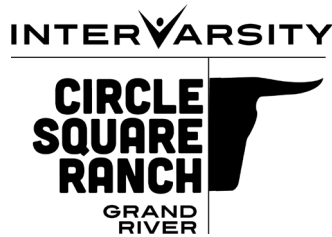
